The link as such is supposed to be "broken" since it points to a directory which cannot be browsed. It his however just a base URL and once you add it to the installer or to the maintenance tool it will be expended to point to for example <http://nds2.fds-forum.nokia.com/extras/inapppurchase/repository/Updates.xml> (this file exists) and other URLs are constructed based on XML file's content.

Yes, the IPs change all the time since there are many servers around the world delivering the content and you are always connected to the server closest to you. The example I gave shows one of the IPs of the server close to my location, yours will be different and in order for us to investigate it, we need to know the IP of the server you are connecting to.
